

Vacation Highlights

Day 1 Rome: Welcome dinner at 5pm.

Day 2 Rome-Assisi: Explore Rome's ancient wonders, including the Colosseum, Pantheon, Piazza Navona, and Trevi Fountain. Then travel through Umbria to Assisi, ending with a local wine tasting.

Day 3 Assisi-Venice Island: Visit the hilltop town of Assisi, birthplace of St. Francis, with free time to explore the Basilica or stroll its medieval streets before continuing north to Venice Island.

Day 4 Venice Island: Join a guided walking tour through St. Mark's Square with skip-the-line access to the Doge's Palace and its famous Bridge of Sighs, or stroll through charming alleyways ending with a drink at a historic café overlooking iconic landmarks.

Day 5 Venice Island-Pisa-Florence: Drive across the Apennine Mountains into Tuscany, stopping in Pisa to visit the UNESCO-listed Square of Miracles and its Leaning Tower, then continue to in Florence.

Day 6 Florence: Explore Florence's artistic heart with a guided visit to see Michelangelo's David at the Academy of Fine Arts, followed by a walk through the historic center to admire the cathedral, Giotto's Bell Tower, and Signoria Square, with free time afterward to enjoy the city at your leisure.

Day 7 Florence-Siena-Rome: Join a guided walk through Siena's medieval streets to the famous Piazza del Campo, learn about the historic Palio horse race, sample traditional sweets like panforte and ricciarelli, then return to Rome.

Day 8 Rome: Enter Vatican City for a guided tour of the Vatican Museums and Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel ceiling, then continue to St. Peter's Square to admire the Basilica, ending the day with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 9 Rome: Your vacation ends this morning.
